We have issued Parking Charge Notice (PCN) to your vehicle because it was parked in a manner whereby the driver became liable for a parking charge at Silver Blades, Gillingham, ME8 0PU that we are authorised to manage on the 29th December 2021 at 21:00. The terms and conditions of parking on this private land are clearly set out on the signage installed within the car park. By parking within this car park the driver is bound to these terms and conditions and liable to pay a charge if they breach these terms and conditions. The reason we issued the PCN to the vehicle is as follows: **Whole Period Of Parking Not Paid For**

A prompt payment discounted amount of £60.00 applies if this Parking Charge Notice is paid within 14 days of issue. If you choose to not pay at this amount, the full value of £100.00 will be due. The Registered Keeper details of this vehicle have been requested from the DVLA through the reasonable cause criteria of pursuing an outstanding Parking Charge Notice. If you were not the keeper of the vehicle at the time it was parked or if the vehicle was stolen prior to the beginning of the period of parking which is the subject of this Notice, please let us know. If you were not the driver, please supply the full name and current serviceable postal address of the driver so that liability of the Parking Charge Notice may be transferred to the driver.

We now request this amount is paid using one of the payment methods described overleaf. You are advised that if, after 29 days from the date given (which is presumed to be the second working day after the Date Issued), the parking charge has not been paid in full and we do not know both the name and current address of the driver, we, Premier Park Ltd (the Creditor) have the right to recover any unpaid part of the parking charge from you. This Notice is given to you under Paragraph 9(2)(f) of Schedule 4 of the Protection of Freedoms Act 2012 and is subject to our complying with the applicable conditions under Schedule 4 of that Act. Failure to pay the full amount of this notice within 28 days may result in the proceeding of debt recovery action and/or issuing court proceedings against you. Additional costs may be incurred.
